



IMPORTANT FACTS FOR SELLERS

Thank you for consigning to the 2019 LG International Barrel Horse Sale. Please read the sale conditions and contact us if you have any questions. 1-405-282-3004.

- All horses must check-in at the Sale Office by **Thursday, February 14 at 8pm CST**.
- Stalls will be in the Indoor Arena and will be available Tuesday, February 12 at 8am CST.
- Sale Office Hours are – **Thursday Noon – 8pm, Friday 8am – 8pm, Saturday 8am – 8pm**.
- The Indoor Arena will be closed every night, however, sale consignors may access the Arena by showing their credentials to the security officer which will be located by the North End of the Arena.
- Original registration documents are due at check-in (registration papers, signed transfer, signed contract).
- You must notify the sale office of any necessary changes to original certificates of registration regarding color, markings, added brands, or gelding status OR of any corrections to the sale catalog prior to the sale.
- Original Coggins dated within 6 months and 30-day Health Certificate. COPIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Stalls & hip numbers are pre-assigned and cannot be changed. Sale hip order was sorted randomly.
- Demonstrations will be Friday, February 15 at approximately 6pm. Horses will be allowed in the arena in groups of 5 (based on hip numbers) for a group warm-up, after 5-minutes horses will be allowed in the arena for 2-minutes for a solo demonstration. The demonstrations will be filmed and will be shown during the sale. Demonstrations are not mandatory, but encouraged.
- The sale will begin Saturday, February 16 at approximately 6pm.
- It is your responsibility to get your horse to & from the auction arena. All horses will be presented in the auction arena by one of the Lazy E Arena representatives.
- Owners are asked to please refrain from personally using the auction PA system to comment as a horse is selling. If an owner has additional details to add in the sale of a horse, it may be done by submitting a written note for announcement or commenting clearly to the professionals on the auction block for announcement.
- PRIVATE SALES COMMONLY REFERED TO AS “ALLEY SALES” ARE NOT PERMITTED. Every owner has entered into a contract to sell each horse cataloged at auction. This authority is irrevocable, thus no horse may be sold privately before it is offered publically. If a horse is “repurchased” in the auction arena, the private sale of that horse is encouraged provided all settlements are made directly to the sale office.
- Consignor must make known to the Auctioneer, for announcement, that the horse has been repurchased BEFORE LEAVING THE AUCTION ARENA.
